AWARDS

Awards will be presented in each category for 1-2-3 placements, BUT the greater emphasis of the competition will be on participation. Each pre-registered participant earning a total of 10+ merits from a combination of Martial Arts & Fitness events will be awarded a handsome 4 foot trophy.

SERVICE PROJECT

The Battle of Kennesaw has partnered with local service organizations to provide food, toys and gift certificates to needy families during the Holiday Season. Each participant will receive merits for turning in can food donations, toy donations or gift certificates to local stores. ETO and service organizations will provide gift baskets to special families who are in need.

MARTIAL ARTS SCHOLARSHIPS

“Modern Day Warrior 2017” scholarship award nominations/applications (ages 12-20) may be submitted no later than October 15. Include a brief write-up of how the individual demonstrates the true spirit of martial arts in the training room and in the community. \$100.00 savings bonds will be awarded to the winners announced on event day.

DIRECTIONS TO BATTLE OF KENNSAW

From I-75 North: traveling North on I-75, take Exit 273, Wade Green Rd., and turn right. Follow Wade Green until it dead ends into Highway 92. Turn left onto Highway 92, and FPS is on the left, about ½ mile down. Pass the school on the left, make a U-turn at the next left turn lane, and the school entrance is on your right.

From I- 75 South: traveling South on I-75, take Exit 273, Wade Green Rd. and turn left. Follow Wade Green until it dead ends into Highway 92. Turn left onto Highway 92, and FPS is on the left, about ½ mile down. Pass the school on the left, make a U-turn at the next left turn lane, and the school entrance is on your right.

Weigh In:

All sparring competitors will be weighed in on Sat. 8:00 -9:00 AM

Rules: Full uniforms must be worn in all forms and sparring divisions. Cardio kick divisions may wear workout attire. Light contact in all sparring divisions will be strictly enforced. Illegal targets include: throat, neck, spine, joints and all areas below the belt. Spectators will not be allowed on the competition floor. (Only staff members, judges and competitors are allowed on competition floor.)

Equipment:

Soft safety gear is mandatory in all sparring divisions. These items include: hands, feet, & head gear, groin (men), & mouthpieces.

Creative Forms (musical or gymnastics – 90 sec. time limit)

Weapons

Breaking (1-3 stations, 1 station may be concrete break)

Sparring

Demo Teams (3-5 person teams, 3 minute limit)

Individual Cardio Kickboxing & Team

*(Cardio Kick Individual routines and 3-5 person teams guidelines - 3 minute time limit, judged on strength, stamina, flexibility and martial arts incorporation)

Tae Yo Chi Exhibition (3 minute limit, low impact demonstration must include strength & flexibility, may include components of Yoga, Tai Chi & Pilates, individual or team)

2 Person Tug of War

Can Food Drive (requirement 6+ cans)
